Course Overview:

This 10-week course is based on the standards of the AORN's Peri-operative 101 Program. This course is focused on training and education to registered nurses who are either new graduates or have been previously employed in non-OR nursing positions.

The course includes classroom lectures, lab skills practice, simulation and observational experiences and skill implementation in the surgical setting. As part of this blended course, participants will work with the online learning modules delivered through the AORN's e-learning platform. By the end of the course, participants will have acquired the basic knowledge and fundamental skills necessary to function in entry level peri-operative nursing positions.

Course Objectives:

- Demonstrate proficiency and independence in performing selected clinical skills.
- Apply nursing actions based on appropriate scientific rationale.
