

## MSSM Wireless Guide for MACs



### Apple settings for wireless access:

- ❖ Click on the Apple menu and select **System Preferences**.
- ❖ Click on **Network**.
- ❖ Double-click on **AirPort**, in the list of network connections.

(If AirPort is not shown, you will have to enable it. Click on the **Show:** menu box and select **Network Port Configurations**. Tick the box next to **AirPort**, and click **Apply Now**. You should now be able to select **AirPort** from the Show: box.)

- ❖ Make sure that **Show AirPort status in menu bar** is ticked.
- ❖ Click on the TCP/IP tab, and select **Using DHCP** from the Configure IPv4 box.
- ❖ On the PPPoE tab, make sure that **Connect Using PPPoE** is unticked.
- ❖ On the AppleTalk tab, make sure that **Make AppleTalk Active** is unticked.
- ❖ Click **Apply Now**.

**Note:** Once you have done this, you will be able to manage your wireless connections from the Wireless menu in the menu bar.
