Thank you for your interest in the Masters Degree program at The Mount Sinai School of Medicine, Department of Dermatology. The Department of Dermatology at the Mount Sinai School of Medicine offers an extensive array of didactic courses to medical students, residents and visiting fellows. Our Masters of Science Program differs substantially from dermatology residencies in that a wider array of course offerings are available to those in our Masters Program. In addition, a key part of the Program involves working on a project worthy of publication, such as hypothesis-driven projects. In conjunction with an individual advisor, applicants for a Masters Degree will be required to work on projects worthy of publication.

If you are a foreign medical graduate, all certifications, visas, and entry permits must be current and valid, for the duration of the training program, prior to final approval of any applicant. All licenses, ECFMG certification, INS visa and professional certifications are the applicant's responsibility. The Department does not operate its own J-1 or H-1 program.

To apply, please submit the following documents:

1. A completed application form
2. A Curriculum Vitae
3. A personal statement
4. Three letters of recommendation in sealed envelopes (one of which must be from your residency program director)
5. A copy of your medical school graduation certificate/diploma
6. A copy of your ECFMG certificate (if applicable)
7. A list of completed or submitted abstracts or publications
8. Optional: a passport size photo. (Note: the photo is not used in the selection process)

Following a review of your application and letters of recommendation, you will be contacted if an **invitation to interview is to be extended by the Program Director**. The deadline for applications is December 1<sup>st</sup> for the following academic year (starts July 1<sup>st</sup>).
