Mission

To provide a "home away from home" in NYC for all transplant patients and their families. By offering secure and affordable housing, TLC strives to reduce the emotional and financial stress of a life-threatening illness by providing a network of support and comfort.



The TLC facility

Located within walking distance of the Mount Sinai Medical Center, our 10 bedroom, 8 bath facility has 2 full kitchens and large communal dining and living areas. TLC is located in The Normandie Court, a 24 hour concierge and doorman attended building which offers coin operated laundry facilities, a sun deck and health club lounge with indoor pool and an indoor parking garage.

Tender loving care

Incorporated in 1992, TLC is a not for profit corporation which is governed by a board of directors. TLC is completely privately funded and volunteer staffed and it is our caring volunteers who are truly the "spirit of TLC". They will be on hand to check guests in and out, answer questions and provide ancillary support and comfort.

Who is eligible

All transplant family members are eligible. However, some guests are immune suppressed and TLC is therefore unable to accommodate anyone with a communicable disease or any children who have not yet received their inoculations.

What to do

If you would like to stay at TLC, please call 212-348-3308. Your call will be received by a TLC volunteer who will make the appropriate arrangements. Since accommodations are provided on a first come, first served basis, your name will be placed on our waiting list. Every effort will be made to accommodate you and ensure your comfort.



For all guests

We have strived to create a warm and home-like atmosphere. TLC is completely furnished. Fresh linens are provided for all guests and housekeeping services are provided for all communal areas. Our kitchens are equipped with everything from frying pans to baking tins and apothecary jars abound with chocolate kisses.

Fees

Guests are required to pay one week in advance and to keep all payments up to date. TLC accepts cash, checks, Master and Visa cards.

TLC house policies

- Everyone is asked to help keep our home clean.
- Anyone with a communicable disease will be denied admission.
- Alcohol, smoking, illegal drugs and firearms are strictly prohibited.
- Children under the age of sixteen must be supervised by an adult. TLC volunteers are not permitted to baby sit.
- TLC telephones are for local use only. Telephone numbers for guests usage are: 212-348-3359 and 212-348-3228.
- TLC assumes no responsibility for lost or stolen items.

Life in NYC

- Parking is expensive and can cost \$35.00 or more per day.
- Apply for a telephone credit card or bring a cell phone. Make it easy to stay in touch.
- Apply for an auto-teller bank card.
- There is an ATM machine in the main lobby of Normandie Court.
- Mass transit is at our doorstep. Exact fare in coins is necessary.
- Taxi service is convenient and readily available for a nominal fee.
- The public library is located one block from TLC.
- Central Park is just a short walk from home.
- Remember to bring a stroller for young children.
- There are several supermarkets in the immediate vicinity of TLC.
- There are many restaurants at our doorstep.
- Museum Mile is just two blocks away.
