

OFFICIAL RULES

2026 US Open Finals Sweepstakes Promotion, Presented by Mount Sinai

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN THIS SWEEPSTAKES. A PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED OR RESTRICTED BY LAW.

This sweepstakes, solely sponsored by the Mount Sinai Health System (“Mount Sinai” or “Sponsor”), is intended for play in the fifty (50) United States and District of Columbia only and shall be construed and evaluated according to United States law. Do not enter this sweepstakes if you are not a legal resident of and located in the United States or the District of Columbia at the time of entry. This sweepstakes is open only to legal residents of the United States and the District of Columbia who are eighteen (18) years of age or older. Void outside the fifty (50) United States, the District of Columbia and where prohibited. Sweepstakes begins at time of post announcement on Thursday, August 13, 2026 and ends at 11:59:00 p.m. EST on Monday, September 7, 2026 (the “Sweepstakes Period” or “Promotional Period”).

HOW TO ENTER. To enter the 2026 US Open Finals Sweepstakes Promotion, Presented by Mount Sinai, also known or referred to as the 2026 Finals Ticket Sweepstakes (the “2026 Finals Sweeps”), visit mountsinai.org/usopensweeps, click the electronic link to access the Finals Sweeps official online entry form, and provide the registration information as prompted, which may include: each entrant’s first name and last name; email address; telephone number; zip code; birth year or birth date; and other potential contact information. Entrant must complete and submit the entry form with all required information for the entry to be qualified and eligible. Two (2) separate Grand Prize winners will be selected at random, as further described below. Online entries must be received by 11:59:00 p.m. EST on Monday, September 7, 2026. Limit of one (1) online entry per email address during the Sweepstakes Period. All entries become the sole property of the Mount Sinai Health System and will not be acknowledged or returned. Entries will be declared made by the authorized account holder of the email address submitted at the time of entry. “Authorized account holder” is defined as the natural person who is assigned to the email address by an Internet access provider, on-line service provider, or other organization (such as a business, educational institution, etc.) that is responsible for assigning email addresses for the domain associated with the submitted email address. The authorized account holder may be required to provide proof of identity. Any other attempted form of entry is prohibited; no automatic, programmed, robotic or similar means of entry are permitted.

ELIGIBILITY. The 2026 Finals Sweeps is open only to legal residents of the fifty (50) United States and the District of Columbia, who are eighteen (18) years of age or older. By participating in this Sweepstakes, participants agree to be bound by these Official Rules. Employees of Mount Sinai Health System, Inc., Mount Sinai Hospitals Group, Inc., Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai, and any of their affiliate companies shall not be eligible to enter or win this sweepstakes. Additionally, employees, officers, and directors of the United States Tennis Association Incorporated (the “USTA”), USTA National Tennis Center Incorporated, and the USTA's family of companies and affiliate companies, and their immediate family members and those living in the same household as such individuals (whether legally related or not) shall not be eligible to enter or win this sweepstakes. Mount Sinai reserves the right to disqualify from this Sweepstakes any person it believes has intentionally violated these Rules.

DRAWING; ODDS. Winners will be selected in a random drawing from all eligible entries received during the Promotional Period, such drawing to be held on or about Wednesday, September 9, 2026. Drawing will be conducted by the Mount Sinai Marketing Department and Strategic Partnerships personnel (the “Promotional Administrator”), whose decisions will be final and binding in all respects. Odds of winning depend upon the total number of eligible entries received.

PRIZES. One (1) First Grand Prize Package will be awarded, consisting of two (2) Loge tickets to EITHER the: A) Women’s Singles Final match (Session #26 to be held on Saturday, September 12, 2026 at 4:00 pm); OR B) Men’s Singles Final match (Session #27 to be held on Sunday, September 13, 2026 at 2:00 pm) during the 2026 US Open Tennis Championships in Arthur Ashe Stadium at the USTA Billie Jean King National Tennis Center in Flushing Meadows, New York. The First Grand Prize winner will have the option to choose EITHER the Women’s Singles Final match OR Men’s Singles Final match at his/her/their discretion. The First Grand Prize Package also includes a

gift bag of branded merchandise and apparel. Approximate retail value of First Grand Prize Package: \$2500 USD/ARV.

Additionally, one (1) Second Grand Prize Package will be awarded, consisting of two (2) Loge tickets to EITHER the: A) 2026 Women's Singles Final match; OR B) 2026 Men's Singles Final match, as described above. Mount Sinai will confirm for the winner which match is available. The Second Grand Prize Package also includes a gift bag of branded merchandise and apparel. Approximate retail value of Second Grand Prize Package: \$2500 USD/ARV.

The US Open schedule of play as well as session dates, number of matches and starting times (and the opening of venue gates) are subject to change by USTA/NTC in its sole discretion, and no such change shall entitle the Grand Prize winners to a refund or any other remedy if winners cannot attend the US Open (or any session thereof) or for any other reason. US Open tickets are subject to all ticket terms and conditions, as well as all venue and US Open procedures, policies, protocols and mitigation measures, including, without limitation, security and guest conduct, health and safety, and applicable bag policies, and ticket holders must comply and abide by all such terms, conditions, procedures, policies, protocols and mitigation measures.

Both of the two (2) 2026 Finals Sweeps winners are solely responsible for all other expenses not specifically set forth herein, including but not limited to: travel, airfare, or ground transportation; hotels or other lodging; meals, dining, food, or beverage; insurance, gratuities, or incidentals; plus any other potential costs or time incurred.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS. Potential winners will be notified by telephone and/or email on or before 10:00 am [EST] on Wednesday, September 9, 2026. If prize/prize notification is returned as undeliverable or not responded to within twenty-four (24) hours, such prize will be forfeited, and an alternate winner will be selected. Any traveler under eighteen (18) years old must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian during all aspects of the Grand Prize trip at his or her own expense, unless such parent or legal guardian is the selected winner. In the event of non-compliance with any of these requirements, prize may be forfeited and awarded to an alternate winner. Upon verification of eligibility, prize winner will be notified by telephone and/or email regarding the details of the prize. By accepting the prize, the winner agrees to accept the prize in the manner set forth by the Mount Sinai Health System. The Grand Prize is only valid on the event date. If the potential Grand Prize winners are unable to take the trip during this time, such winner will be disqualified and an alternate Grand Prize winner will be selected from the remaining eligible entries, provided sufficient time remains prior to the match. Mount Sinai is not responsible if the event is rained out or postponed, or cancelled after ticketing of prize for any reason, in whole or in part. In that event, no compensation will be paid in lieu of tickets. Prize is not redeemable for cash.
