

Mount Sinai Plasma Collection Center Seeking New Donors

In partnership with ImmunoTek Bio Centers, the Mount Sinai Health System has opened a COVID-19 convalescent plasma collection facility at 1440 Madison Avenue, near 99th Street. This plasma will be purified into hyperimmune globulin, which will be used to perform research trials throughout our Health System for the prevention and treatment of COVID-19. As employees of the Mount Sinai Health System, you are an integral part of this mission.

We are seeking donors who have recovered from COVID-19 to donate their convalescent plasma. If you have tested positive for SARS-CoV-2 antibodies and you have a high concentration of antibodies, you may be a candidate for plasma donation.
