Mount Sinai Plasma Collection Center Seeking Newly Vaccinated Donors

The Mount Sinai Plasma Collection Center is seeking individuals who previously recovered from COVID-19. Recovered individuals who have also received the COVID-19 vaccine are exceptional candidates for plasma donation.

Through March 1, qualified donors will be compensated \$150 for every completed donation. Employees are permitted to donate during scheduled shifts with manager approval. Donors may donate up to twice within each seven-day period.

Through our partnership with Emergent BioSolutions and ImmunoTek Bio Centers, donated plasma will be purified into hyperimmune globulin, which will be used in research trials for treatment and prevention of COVID-19.

If you are interested in donating, please complete the prescreening questionnaire. You may also share this with patients who may qualify. The information shared in this questionnaire will be kept private and used exclusively for donor recruitment for plasma donation. If you have previously completed the questionnaire and you have recently been vaccinated, please contact our team so we can update our records.
