

# Report Your Booster Shot to EHS

January 10, 2022, Monday

As more of you are getting booster shots, I want to remind you to please report your vaccines to Employee Health Services (EHS). If you have received your COVID-19 booster shot and not yet reported it to EHS, you can do so [here](#).

Booster shots must be reported even if you have already reported your initial vaccine doses, and even if you got your booster shot at Mount Sinai. The process for reporting your booster is the same as for your initial vaccination; you can give EHS permission to access your vaccine record in Epic if you were vaccinated at Mount Sinai, or upload a picture of your vaccination card if you received the booster elsewhere.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) now [recommends](#) that all Americans ages 12 and over **should** get a booster shot once eligible. You can book an appointment [through Mount Sinai](#), or check the [New York State](#), [New York City](#), [New Jersey](#), or [Connecticut](#) websites for other locations. As a reminder, the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) have shortened the wait time for Pfizer and Moderna boosters from six months to five months after the second dose.
