# **Annual Influenza Vaccine Is Available**

September 14, 2020, Monday

It is especially important to get your flu shot this year.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention has recommended that all individuals six months of age or older be vaccinated by the end of October or earlier. One reason is that the flu can mimic signs and symptoms of COVID-19. Additionally, the flu vaccine will help prevent co-infection with both influenza and the COVID-19 virus, which can lead to worse outcomes. By getting vaccinated, you protect yourself, your family, and your patients.

Even if you are working from home, it is important to get vaccinated to protect yourself and your family. Below, you will find information about getting a flu shot while working from home.

Employee Health Services (EHS) will be providing the flu vaccine to all Mount Sinai Health System staff, including volunteers. There is no cost to staff and volunteers who receive their flu vaccine through EHS.

EHS will be providing flu vaccines at local places of distribution (PODs) across Mount Sinai campuses and at local EHS offices. To ensure appropriate physical distancing, **appointments are required at both the PODs and EHS**. Click <u>here</u> to make an appointment. Upon receiving the vaccine, staff will receive a "21 FLU" sticker for their Mount Sinai ID badges.

If you are working from home, you are welcome to make an appointment at the EHS office closest to where you live. Flu vaccines are also available at your local pharmacy or primary care provider's office. This may be a more convenient option for employees who do not live near a Mount Sinai campus. If you receive the flu vaccine at a non-EHS location (e.g. pharmacy, MD office, other site) you must submit written documentation to EHS which includes the date of the vaccination, where you received the vaccine, and who administered the vaccine. You can bring

the documentation or fax it to any EHS site; a list of locations and fax numbers can be found <u>here</u>.
