



¹ This algorithm applies to all surgeries/procedures performed in the main operating room, major procedural areas (cardiac catheterization, electrophysiology, endoscopy, intervential radiology), and procedural locations performing at least moderate sedation. A procedure may proceed even with a positive COVID-19 PCR test or COVID symptoms, such as in an emergency or based on medical need. A collaborative discussion should be had to weigh the risks and benefits among the patient, surgeon, and anesthesiologist.
