Opening of Plasma Collection Center

July 8, 2020, Wednesday

On Monday, July 13, we will be opening a Plasma Collection Center at The Mount Sinai Hospital at 1440 Madison Avenue to collect convalescent plasma from individuals who have recovered from COVID-19. This plasma will be purified into hyperimmune globulin, which will be used in clinical research trials at Mount Sinai and elsewhere to test its ability to prevent and treat COVID-19.

As faculty, staff, and students of The Mount Sinai Hospital and the Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai, you are an integral part of this mission. If you have a high concentration of antibodies to SARS-CoV-2 (titers of 1:320 or higher), you may be a candidate for plasma donation. Should you wish to consider donation, please use this link to complete the <u>prescreening questionnaire</u>. Your confidentiality will be maintained and used exclusively for donor recruitment for plasma donation. Employees may work with their supervisor to donate plasma during work hours, if conditions permit.
