WHAT'S NEW:

Governor Andrew Cuomo yesterday banned all events with 500 or more people and announced that any gathering under 500 individuals will be required to cut capacity by 50 percent. As a result of this and other similar orders elsewhere, Broadway theaters closed last night, and all major music and entertainment tours and sporting events have been postponed or their seasons cancelled. However, despite rumors to the contrary, all NYC public transportation remains open and on a regular schedule.
