I AM finding gender affirming services

Our Center for Transgender Medicine and Surgery (CTMS) offers healthcare services for transgender and gender non-conforming patients who wish to begin or continue their transitions; this includes top/bottom surgeries, endocrinology, mental health care, insurance assistance, and more.

We offer gender-affirming surgeries performed by experienced surgeons, including genital, breast/chest, and facial procedures. CTMS also provides primary care, endocrinology, reproductive counseling, spiritual counseling, mental health care, and social support to make your transition as easy as possible.

We help our patients work with their health insurance to obtain necessary approvals for pre-surgical and surgical transitioning reimbursements.
