In the office, you'll meet our team of nephrologists (medical kidney stone doctors), urologists (surgical kidney stone doctors), and nutritionists. Behind the scenes, there is an even bigger team of doctors, nurses, pharmacists, radiologists, and laboratory specialists who help us

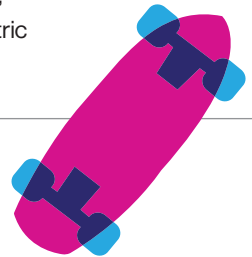

To treat your child's kidney stone, there are several options or procedures that your doctor might recommend.

We also work with specially trained anesthesiologists who are skilled in helping kids through surgical procedures.
