

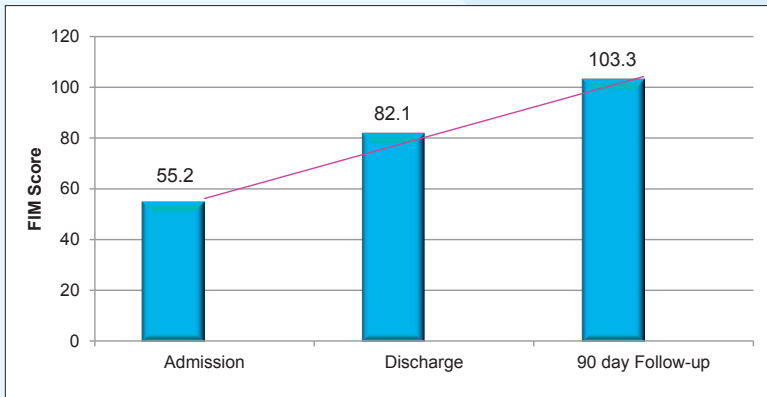


# Mount Sinai Rehabilitation Center 2017 Scorecard Stroke Specialty Program

### **Functional Improvement**



The Functional Independence Measure (FIM) is the gold standard for measuring function in the rehabilitation industry. Our patients make significant gains in function and independence during their inpatient stay and outpatient program.

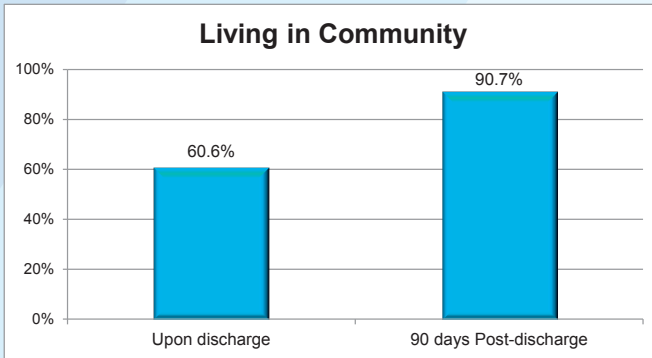
### **Goal Attainment**

84% of our patients meet their goals during their stay at the Mount Sinai Rehabilitation Center

## ***Intensity of Therapy***

On average, our patients receive 3.2 hours of therapy per day, including Physical and Occupational Therapy, Speech Language Pathology and Neuropsychology. Supplemental activities are offered daily by our Therapeutic Recreational Specialists.

## ***Discharge***



The majority of our patients are discharged back to the community following inpatient rehabilitation. Some patients (28%) require further rehabilitation in a sub-acute setting prior to returning home. A small percentage (11.4%) require transfer to the acute hospital for further medical management.
