Norma Pinto didn't have to choose between a leading respiratory center or a leading academic medical institution. Her constrictive bronchiolitis continued to worsen for over 20 years, despite the efforts of her local hospital. So she came to the new Mount Sinai-National Jewish Health Respiratory Institute. This unique partnership is a model for state-of-the-art, personalized medicine for the treatment of respiratory disease.

Here, she was diagnosed by a multidisciplinary team of physicians. The team prescribed medication to strengthen Norma's compromised immune system, and enrolled her in a clinical trial of a new drug which improved her breathing.
