Mandi Pek is an Advanced Clinical Nutrition Coordinator at The Mount Sinai Hospital of the Mount Sinai Health System. She received her undergraduate degree in Psychology from Syracuse University and Master of Science degree in Clinical Nutrition from New York University. Mandi is a Registered Dietitian, licensed Certified Dietitian-Nutritionist in New York State and Board-Certified Specialist in Pediatric Nutrition (CSP).

She began her career at Mount Sinai twelve years ago in the pediatric in-patient units as well as the pediatric and neonatal intensive care units, where she continues today.
